



Encircling Spa hill, this reef is synonymous with sightings of Grey reef shark and very inquisitive turtles as well as the rare Indian Ocean walkman. Schools of Humphead parrotfish and lobster are also common.

BOULDERS
[8-20 meters]

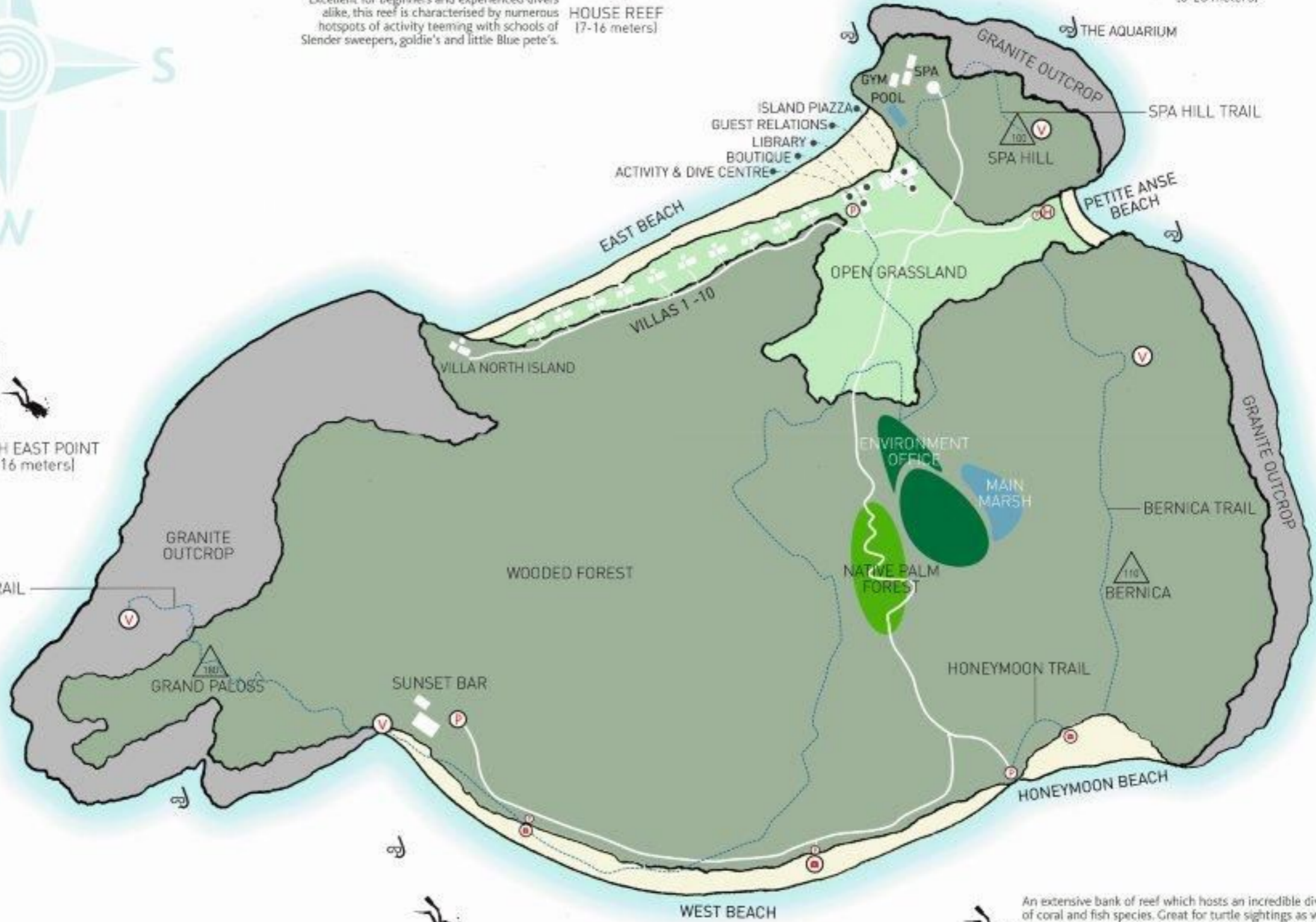
Excellent for beginners and experienced divers alike, this reef is characterised by numerous hotspots of activity teeming with schools of Slender sweepers, goldie's and little Blue pete's.

HOUSE REEF
[7-16 meters]

Situated below steep cliffs off Grand Paloss, this reef hosts a myriad of small fish species as well as numerous Geometric morays and the occasional barracuda. Nurse sharks are also occasionally spotted here.

An extensive bank of reef which hosts an incredible diversity of coral and fish species. Great for turtle sightings as well as Spotted eagle rays, Potato bass and octopus. Excellent for nudibranch sightings.
